On June 26, 2008, Jeff Nelson of American Public Media and Erik Hotmire of Clark & Weinstock met with Rosemary Harold, Deputy Bureau Chief, Media Bureau; Royce Sherlock, Industry Analysis Division Chief, Media Bureau; Marcia Glauber, Industry Analysis Deputy Division Chief, Media Bureau; Rebekah Goodheart, Industry Analysis Assistant Division Chief, Media Bureau; Kristi Thompson, Media Bureau; and Gardner Foster, Attorney, International Bureau; to discuss American Public Media's previously filed comments regarding the XM-Sirius license transfer review proceeding (MB Docket No. 07-57).

American Public Media restated arguments consistent with its comment filed on June 20, 2008, and urged the Commission to impose a 25 percent set aside condition of the total satellite radio spectrum (SDARS) for non-commercial public service channels, minority broadcasters and emergency services, and requested the advice of the Media Bureau as to how a set aside may be administered.
