On June 26, 2008, Kathleen Grillo and Chris Miller of Verizon met separately with Scott Bergmann, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, and Wayne Leighton, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate. The purpose of these meetings was to discuss InterCall's request for review of the Universal Service Administrative Company's decision requiring InterCall to contribute to the universal service fund on its retail audio conferencing revenues and InterCall's related petition for a stay of contributions to the USF pending resolution of its appeal. Verizon requested quick and decisive action to remedy the major competitive disadvantage that InterCall's conduct creates. Verizon repeated that it takes no position on InterCall's potential retroactive liability for contributions to the fund in prior years.
