**ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S**  
**STATEMENT OF READINESS FOR HEARING**

1. The Enforcement Bureau, pursuant to the Presiding Judge's *Order*, FCC 08M-28 (released May 16, 2008) and *Order*, FCC 08M-31 (released June 18, 2008), hereby submits its Statement of Readiness for Hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therein, the Presiding Judge instructed the parties each file a Statement of Readiness listing witnesses to be cross examined noting whether the examination is to be by speakerphone, teleconference or in person, and accompanied by any additional documents to be placed into evidence.

2. The Bureau intends to call Detective Robert Shilling, Mr. John Schurman as direct case witnesses, and to call Mr. David Titus as an adverse witness. Detective Shilling will appear in person. Mr. Titus and Mr. Schurman will appear via teleconference. The Bureau intends to cross examine Mr. Titus and Dr. Douglas Allmon, Mr. Titus' expert witness. This cross examination will also be by teleconference.
