On July 2, 2008, on behalf of American Public Media, Erik J. Hotmire of Clark & Weinstock emailed Amy Blankenship, Legal Advisor for Children, Family and Media Issues for Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate to underscore American Public Media's previously filed comments regarding the XM-Sirius license transfer review proceeding (MB Docket No. 07-57).

Mr. Hotmire restated arguments consistent with American Public Media's comment filed on June 20, 2008, and urged the Commission to impose a 25 percent set aside condition of the total satellite radio spectrum (SDARS) for non-commercial public service channels, minority broadcasters and emergency services.
