
Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter provides notice that on July 7, 2008, Harold Furchtgott-Roth participated in a telephone conversation with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate regarding the above captioned proceeding in which changes are proposed to the technical rules governing both SDARS and WCS to enable coexistence of both services.

The ten-year delay in adopting appropriate rules for these adjacent services is hindering WCS wireless broadband equipment development, network design, and service deployment and is jeopardizing the ability of WCS licensees to meet their substantial service deadline of July of 2010.

In view of the Commission's extensive experience in handling the type of adjacent channel coexistence issues that are presented by WCS and SDARS, and given that the record already contains the information the Commission needs to make a decision, now is an opportune time to bring this rulemaking to a conclusion.
