Further to the meeting that representatives of inmate telephone service providers held July 1, 2008, with several members of Commission Staff (see notice of *ex parte* presentation filed July 2, 2008), the undersigned, counsel for Securus Technologies, Inc. (parent of T-Netix, Inc. and Evercom Systems, Inc.), notifies you that a detailed cost analysis of inmate telecommunications will be filed in the above-named proceeding.

Several providers of inmate telecommunications service, at present count at least seven, will participate in this cost analysis. These providers jointly have retained an independent economics expert to whom they will submit proprietary, non-public cost data. The expert will analyze the data and will submit, in the public record, an aggregate analysis of industry costs. This cost analysis will be filed no later than August 15, 2008.
