

I am appealing the decision that our technology plan was not approved by a USAC-certified Technology Plan Approver prior to the commencement of service. Attached is the Technology Plan Approval Letter. We are in compliance with FCC rules that the Technology Plan be approved before the start of services.

The plan was written prior to posting the FCC Form 470 and/or request for Proposal.

The plan did contain the five required elements.

I am sending this letter at this time because of all the confusion with paperwork. When I looked for the paperwork for the technology plan approval, I was denied access at the State level because there is another person named Sue A. Grzegorzcyk who accesses information. This problem was resolved after it came to light that two of us were trying to get into the system.

My understanding was I only had to appeal to USAC, which I did. I heard back from USAC on 4/30/08 about phone service. I was waiting to hear from them regarding Charter. When I talked to someone at USAC to tell them I haven't heard of their decision on Charter, I was told to write to the FCC.
