On July 7, 2008, AdHoc Telecommunications Users Committee, COMPTel, tw telecom inc., and One Communications Corp. filed the *Blueprint For A Compliance Methodology Cost Assignment Plan* (“*Compliance Plan Blueprint*”) in the above-referenced dockets to assist the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) in its review of AT&T’s cost assignment plan.
