I am moving into Gateway Apartments on August 1st.

While I was setting up utilities and stuff, I found out that we are severely limited in internet & TV options. We can only pick Infinity

(Visi.net) for internet and Warner/DirecTV for TV services.

DirecTV is more expensive (\$40+\$10 for each additional tuner box), so \$70 and Mediacom is \$29 and wouldn't require a cable box for those channels that we want. Infinity is 1Mb/sec for \$22, and Mediacom is \$29 for 10Mb/s. We could also get unlimited telephone service from Mediacom for another \$29 and everything would be under one bill.

Under their rules, we would have to pay much more and also have to deal with three different companies. I know there are laws about mandatory access and exclusivity contracts, but it doesn't sound like those would apply to satellite providers. That also still doesn't exclude the owner of the building from making choices that limit choices.
