On Thursday, July 17, 2008 and Friday, July 18, 2008, Lawrence R. Sidman of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP, representing Clear Channel Communications, Inc. ("Clear Channel") had two telephonic conversations with Rudy Brioché, Legal Advisor for Media Issues to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, regarding the proposed XM-Sirius merger.

Specifically, Mr. Sidman sought clarification regarding published reports describing the conditions purportedly suggested by Commissioner Adelstein, particularly that addressing the HD radio tuner. In addition, Mr. Sidman discussed potential mechanisms for enforcement of the equipment-related conditions, addressing interoperable radios and HD tuner reception capability, including holding the assets separate until the conditions are fulfilled.
