To Whom It May Concern:

After reviewing the FCC's Public Notice DA 08-1477 entitled *SPRINT NEXTEL CORPORATION AND CLEARWIRE CORPORATION SEEK FCC CONSENT TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF LICENSES AND AUTHORIZATION*; and the FCC Form 603 Exhibit 1 entitled *DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION AND PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT* I wish to state, for the record, that as the licensee, **Lead Call Sign WLX272**, we -Polk County Catholic Television/Diocese of Orlando- have no objections to the collective applicants filed series of applications pursuant to Section 310(d) of the amended Communications Act of 1934, approve the proposed merger, and feel the combining will best serve the public interest when our 2.5GHz EBS spectrum License is fully deployed utilizing the proposed WIMAX broadband network.

Such a combined deployment, when approved expeditiously by the FCC, will directly benefit the educational use of our license within Florida when deployed. Such FCC approval of the Transaction will immediately enable the -New-Clearwire Corporation to receive \$3.2 billion necessary in essential capital funding to build and operate the critical WIMAX broadband infrastructure needed to deploy the next-generation nationwide mobile wireless broadband services that will benefit the overall educational community within the United States.

In conclusion, we feel that an approved consolidation of the entities will enable the New Clearwire to proceed with the 2.5 GHz nationwide mobile WIMAX network that will enable EBS licensees and their surrounding communities to obtain the substantial public interest and educational benefits from a nationwide mobile WIMAX network at in the 2.5 GHz band. When deployed in our area we will have a new opportunity to serve our community, children, parishioners and faculty with new tools for learning and development on a robust broadband platform.
