Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Catholic Television Network (“CTN”) is an association of Roman Catholic archdioceses and dioceses that operate many of the largest parochial school systems in the United States. CTN’s members use Educational Broadband Service (“EBS”) frequencies in the 2.5 GHz band to distribute educational, instructional, inspirational, and other services to schools, colleges, parishes, community centers, hospitals, nursing homes, residences, and other locations throughout the country. CTN has been an active participant in virtually all FCC proceedings affecting EBS licensees.

The purpose of this letter is to express CTN’s support for approval of the above-referenced transaction between Clearwire Corporation and Sprint Nextel Corporation to create a new, independent nationwide wireless broadband company that will retain the Clearwire name. CTN believes that the transaction will benefit EBS licensees by facilitating the deployment of advanced wireless broadband networks on EBS spectrum. This, in turn, should further the interests of the educational community by enabling EBS licensees to realize the full benefits of broadband deployment in the band.
