Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, the undersigned, along with John Orlando and Martin D. Franks of CBS Corporation, spoke with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and Amy Blankenship, and today spoke with Commissioner Robert McDowell and Cristina Pauzé about the proposed merger of Sirius Satellite Radio, Inc. and XM Satellite Radio Holdings, Inc. In addition, the undersigned also spoke or left a voicemail message today with Catherine Bohigian and Elizabeth Andrión of Chairman Kevin Martin's office, Rick Chessen of Commissioner Michael Copps' office and Rudy Brioché of Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein's office about the merger.

Specifically, we urged the commissioners and their legal advisors to reference within any merger order that the Commission would be issuing the adoption of a rule making proceeding within 30 days to inquire whether the public interest would be served by requiring that all newly manufactured SDARS receivers should be capable of receiving HD radio signals and should allow users to switch easily between the SDARS and HD AM/FM bands so that all consumers would have access to radio equipment that would allow them to switch between digital satellite offerings and terrestrial digital offerings. We also urged that the NPRM inquire as to whether the public interest would be served by requiring that, at some future date, all newly manufactured terrestrial

broadcast radio receivers should be capable of receiving HD radio signals and that the proceeding be concluded within 180 days.
