Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing on behalf of the Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. (“WCA”) to draw your attention to what appears to be an inadvertent omission from the proposed rules set forth in Appendix A to the *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-referenced proceedings. Specifically, the proposed version of Section 27.14 of the Commission’s Rules contained in Appendix A does not include Section 27.14(o), which sets forth the substantial service obligations of Broadband Radio Service (“BRS”) and Educational Broadband Service (“EBS”) licensees.¹ To avoid any possible future confusion among BRS and EBS licensees, WCA urges that the current requirements of Section 27.14(o) be included in any revised version of Section 27.14 adopted in these proceedings.
