Â On January 31, 2005, SBC and AT&T agreed to merge.

On October 27, 2005 - the US Dept. of Justice approved the SBC-AT&T merger.

On October 31, 2005, the FCC approved such a merger.

Then on December 29, 2006, the FCC approved AT&T and Bell South being approved for merger, less than only 14 months after the SBC-AT&T merger.

Let's be reminded that AT&T was already broken up for being a monopoly and has already been recombined with 3 of the baby bells.
