Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Monday, July 28, 2008, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Paul Garnett, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, and Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA-The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”), met with Aaron Goldberger, Legal Advisor to Chairman Kevin J. Martin, and Brent Greenfield, Special Counsel, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

Consistent with its prior advocacy, CTIA stressed the importance of an expeditious decision from the Commission granting its Petition for Declaratory Ruling and finding that wireless carrier early termination fees are rates under Section 332(c)(3)(A) of the Communications Act and therefore are subject to the Commission’s exclusive jurisdiction.

Further, the parties discussed the FCC’s Commercial Mobile Alert System Third Report and Order addressing, among other things, Commercial Mobile Service Provider election procedures and notifications to customers. Finally, CTIA discussed its recently filed Petition for Declaratory Ruling to Clarify Provisions of Section 332(c)(7)(B) to Ensure Timely Siting Review by local and state zoning authorities.
