

To the Commission:

In the Reply to Opposition to Petition for Reconsideration filed by AMTS Consortium LLC; Telesaurus-VPC LLC; Intelligent Transportation & Monitoring Wireless LLC; and Warren Havens (collectively, the "Petitioners") in connection with Paging Systems, Inc.'s Opposition to Petition for Reconsideration in the above referenced matter,¹ the Petitioners referenced the Superior Court of the State of California, County of San Mateo case, *Warren C. Havens, et al., vs. Mobex Network Services, LLC, et al.*, Case No: CIV-463985, which included Paging Systems, Inc. as a defendant. This letter is notification to the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") that the Honorable Carol L. Mittlesteadt signed a *Judgment of Dismissal in Favor of Paging Systems, Inc.* dated June 30, 2008, which dismissed the Petitioners' Second Amended Complaint, without leave to amend.
