Notice of Oral *Ex Parte* Communication

RE: Sprint Nextel Corporation and Clearwire Corporation Seek FCC Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations, **WT Docket No. 08-94**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Gerry Salemme and Terri Natoli of Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire"), and Larry Krevor and Trey Hanbury of Sprint/Nextel, met with Chris Moore, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Blaise Scinto, John Schauble, Lynn Ratnavale, and Genevieve Ross of the Broadband Division and Nese Guendelsberger, Susan Singer, Stacy Ferraro, and Joseph Levin of the Spectrum and Competition Policy Division of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the recent applications filed by Clearwire and Sprint for the approval of the transfer of control of licenses, authorizations, and *de facto* transfer spectrum leases held by Clearwire and Sprint to a new wireless broadband company called Clearwire Corporation ("New Clearwire"). Clearwire and Sprint reiterated certain of the points made in its application filed on June 6, 2008.¹ Clearwire and Sprint also noted that over 100 filings had been made in the docket as of the July 24, 2008, the overwhelming majority of which were in unconditional support with only two petitions to deny.
