Representatives of Time Warner Cable Inc. (“TWC”) have received inquiries from interested parties regarding the potential impact, if any, of the separation of TWC from Time Warner Inc. on the requirements regarding access to regional sports network (“RSN”) programming that were imposed on TWC as a condition to the Commission’s approval of TWC’s acquisition of cable systems from Adelphia Communications Corporation.¹ To resolve any uncertainty on this matter, TWC acknowledges that the RSN conditions in the Adelphia Order will remain applicable by their express terms to any Covered RSNs (as defined in the Order) following completion of the Separation Transaction.
