
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of BeamSpeed, LLC (BeamSpeed), I am writing in support of the above-referenced transfer applications filed by Sprint Nextel Corporation and Clearwire Corporation. BeamSpeed is the licensee of Broadband Radio Service ("BRS") in the Geographic Service Areas of BTAs 486 and 124; Yuma, Arizona and El Centro, California respectfully, with stations WLW826, WLW829, WMX652, WMX653, WNT1531, and WMH640, and a variety of EBS leases with area schools. BeamSpeed is a longtime Operator of both BRS and EBS spectrum throughout BTAs 486 and 124 and has previously operated MMDS television services for many years on the spectrum. We currently operate a Commercial Broadband Wireless Service serving High Speed Internet Service to customers all over Yuma and Imperial counties.

As described in their application, the Sprint-Clearwire license transfers will create a new, nationwide WiMAX network based on open standards. We believe that the New Clearwire will enhance competition in both the wireless broadband market and the larger overall broadband market – leading to lower prices for consumers and enhancing access to affordable broadband service to millions of Americans. The network that the New Clearwire has proposed building will stimulate innovation and lower prices for applications and devices consumers will use to communicate with each other and connect to the Internet. As a small BRS Operator BeamSpeed will benefit from open-standard WiMAX technology which will allow new entrants and small businesses to design and deploy their own applications and devices that can run on New Clearwire's nationwide network.

I urge the Commission to approve the Applications of Sprint Nextel Corporation and Clearwire Corporation for Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations File Nos. 0003462540 and 0003368272 et al., WT Docket No. 08-94 and allow the New Clearwire to build and operate the nation's first Open Wireless Broadband Network.
