OnStar Corporation (“OnStar”) hereby provides notice of *ex parte* communications in the above-referenced proceeding. Today, William Ball, Vice-President – Public Policy of OnStar, along with the undersigned, counsel to OnStar, spoke with Commission staff during four separate telephone conferences. Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps, participated in the first conference. Angela Giancarlo, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Robert McDowell, participated in the second conference. Renée Crittendon, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, participated in the third conference. Erika Olsen, Jeff Cohen, Thomas Beers, and Lisa Fowlkes, all from the Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau, participated in the fourth conference.

During the conferences, OnStar reiterated its position as detailed in its Reply Comments. More specifically, OnStar requested that the Commission provide carriers that elect not to deliver emergency alerts significant flexibility regarding how they notify their existing customers and new customers (at point of sale) regarding their election. For example, OnStar suggested that adequate means of notification could include e-mail.
