On August 5, 2008, William Ball, Vice-President – Public Policy of OnStar, along with the undersigned, counsel to OnStar, spoke with Commission staff during two separate telephone conferences. Wayne Leighton, Special Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate, participated in the first conference. Brent Greenfield from the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau participated in the second conference.

During the conferences, OnStar reiterated its position as detailed in its Reply Comments.
