**Re: In the Matter of Applications of Sprint Nextel Corporation and Clearwire Corporation for Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations, WT Docket No. 08-94.**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 6, 2008, Peter Pitsch and Marjorie Dickman of Intel Corporation met with Jim Schlichting, Chris Moore, John Schauble, Blaise Scinto, and Walt Strack of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Jim Bird, Neil Dellar, and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel regarding the above captioned proceeding.

During the meeting, Intel reiterated points from its August 4, 2008 filing.<sup>1</sup> Intel noted that FCC approval of the New Clearwire transaction will significantly advance the public interest by expediting deployment of a nationwide mobile WiMAX network and increasing competition in the broadband marketplace. Intel explained that expeditious approval is a condition precedent to critical OEM platform decisions which depend upon New Clearwire's ability to meet deployment milestones.

Intel further stated that, should the FCC apply a spectrum screen to the transaction, it should not simplistically include BRS/EBS spectrum, but rather refine the spectrum aggregation using objective marketplace valuations (\$ per MHz/pop). In sum, Intel asserted that New Clearwire will indisputably enhance competition, and the record overwhelmingly supports expeditious and unconditional approval of the transaction.
