Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Thomas J. Sugrue, Kathleen O'Brien Ham, and the undersigned, of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), met with Amy Bender, Chairman Kevin Martin's Acting Legal Advisor, and today the same T-Mobile representatives met with Renée Crittendon, Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein's Legal Advisor, to discuss the FCC's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the local number portability proceeding. We reiterated T-Mobile's concerns about the anticompetitive and anti-consumer effects of the current four-day wireline port-out period, and emphasized that prompt implementation of the Commission's proposal to shorten the porting interval is essential. We stated, however, that we would not oppose establishment of a longer implementation period for very small incumbent local exchange carriers. T-Mobile intends to provide the Commission with a proposal on dual implementation tracks.
