**Re: CSR-7216-Z, James Cable LLC's Request for Waiver of the Integration Ban:
Request for Confidentiality Pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Concurrent to this letter, James Cable, LLC ("James Cable") has filed a "Report of Compliance Plan and Petition for Reconsideration" on ECFS in CS Docket 97-80 that redacts certain confidential information described below (the "Confidential Information"). An unredacted version marked "Confidential" has been provided to the Media Bureau. Pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.459, James Cable hereby requests that the confidential version be designated by the Commission as confidential and not be made routinely available for public inspection.

The first item of redacted information is the price at which James Cable could purchase new DCH-200 set-top boxes from Motorola through the National Cable Television Cooperative (NCTC). The contract between Motorola and NCTC requires that this information be kept confidential.

The second item is the price that James Cable could purchase refurbished integrated set-top boxes. This information is commercially sensitive to the sellers of these devices and disclosure of the information could impair James Cable's continued ability to obtain such devices at these prices.

The third item of information describes one of the potential financial consequences that could arise if James Cable loses its waiver. This information could be used by James Cable's

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competitors and potential competitors in a manner that would be likely to cause substantial competitive harm to James Cable.

James Cable is a privately-held company and the Confidential Information has not been disclosed by James Cable to the public. James Cable takes all reasonable precautions to avoid public disclosure of this Confidential Information. For the foregoing reasons, James Cable requests that the aforementioned Confidential Information not be made routinely available for public inspection.
