(GWNW) on behalf of Harrisonville Telephone Company (Company), respectfully files the attached notice pursuant to *Wireline Broadband Order* of the intent of the Company to discontinue its Wireline Broadband Internet Access Service (WBIAS) offerings under Harrisonville Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective October 1, 2008. Upon discontinuance of the tariffed offerings, the Company will provide WBIAS on a common-carriage non-tariff basis. Harrisonville Telephone Company (“Company”) hereby provides notice that it plans to terminate provision of wireline broadband Internet access service (WBIAS) on a tariffed basis effective October 1, 2008 at which time it plans to offer permissive detariffed WBIAS on a Title II common-carriage basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission’s *Wireline Broadband Order*¹. The Company currently offers WBIAS through Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line (“ADSL”) Access Service and Symmetric Digital Subscriber Line (“SDSL”) Access Service under Harrisonville Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

In order to effect the permissive detariffing, the Company will make a tariff filing with the Federal Communications Commission on September 16, 2008 on 15-day notice to remove from its Harrisonville Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 ADSL and SDSL Access Services (hereinafter “WBIAS”) under the tariff effective October 1, 2008.

Impact on Customers

The only customer for the Company’s WBIAS is the Company’s affiliate nonregulated Internet Service Provider (“ISP”) operation. The affiliate purchases WBIAS for use as a component in its broadband Internet service sold to consumers and business customers. The discontinuance of the tariffed offering of WBIAS will have no effect on the end user service provided by the ISP operation.

Serving Area

The Company’s provision of WBIAS is limited to its ILEC serving area in Illinois which consists of seven exchanges.

Future Availability of WBIAS on a Permissive-Detariffed Common Carriage Basis

The Company will continue to make WBIAS available on a common-carriage basis through posting of rates, terms and conditions on its Internet web-site in a manner similar to that required for interstate and international interexchange services under Section 42.10 of the FCC’s rules (47 C.F.R. § 42.10). As required by the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), the Company will continue to make available to its existing customer rates, terms and conditions consistent with the current tariffed rates on a grandfathered basis pursuant to the aforementioned Federal Communications Commission’s *Wireline Broadband Order*.

Dear Mr. Hern:

Effective October 1, 2008, Harrisonville Telephone Company will be providing DSL Access Services on a detariffed basis to Harrisonville Telephone Company's Internet Service Provider (ISP) operation.

DSL Access Services are provided by Harrisonville Telephone Company in all seven exchanges.

A tariff filing will be made with the FCC on 15 days notice effective October 1, 2008 to remove DSL Access Services from the Harrisonville Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

Beginning October 1, 2008 the rates, terms and conditions related to Harrisonville Telephone Company's provision of DSL Access Services will be posted on the company website. A hardcopy will also be available in the business office.
