SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Southeastern Media Holdings, Inc. ("Southeastern"), licensee of WFXG(TV) and permittee of WFXG-DT, Augusta, Georgia, by its attorneys, hereby respectfully supplements its Petition for Rule Making to substitute DTV Channel 31 for DTV Channel 51 as Station WFXG-DT's final, post-transition digital channel. With respect thereto, the following is stated:

1. This Supplement is submitted in response to the letter of the Associate Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau, dated July 21, 2008, with regard to the above-captioned petition. That letter states that Southeastern's Petition for Rule Making is mutually exclusive with modification applications for WMBF-DT, Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, and WRLK-DT, Columbia, South Carolina.

2. Attached hereto is a copy of an Interference Acceptance Agreement which resolve the interference issues raised in the letter of the Associate Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau with regard to WFXG-DT. With those issues resolved, for the reasons set forth in the Petition for Rule Making, it is clear that adoption of the proposed channel change would serve the public interest.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, Southeastern respectfully requests that DTV Channel 31 be substituted for DTV Channel 51 at Augusta, Georgia.

INTERFERENCE ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT

This Interference Acceptance Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of August ____, 2008 by and between Southeastern Media Holdings, Inc. ("Southeastern") and the South Carolina Educational Television Commission ("SCETC").

1. Southeastern is the licensee of television Station WFXG-DT, FCC Facility ID No. 3228, Augusta, Georgia, and holds a construction permit issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") authorizing it to construct a post-transition digital television ("DTV") facility on Channel 51 (see FCC File No. BMPCDT-20080219ATL, hereafter referred to as the "WFXG Permit").

2. SCETC is the licensee of television Station WRLK-DT, FCC Facility ID No. 61013, Columbia, South Carolina, and holds a license issued by the FCC authorizing it to operate a post-transition DTV facility on Channel 32 (see FCC File No. BMLEDT-20040826AAL, hereafter referred to as the "WRLK License").

3. Southeastern and SCETC desire to modify their authorized post-transition DTV facilities and maximize service to the public. SCETC has filed an application to construct DTV facilities that transmit at a higher power than the WRLK License currently authorizes. See File No. BPEDT-20080620ACO ("WRLK Application"). Southeastern has filed a Petition for Rulemaking that seeks a channel substitution that would allow WFXG-DT to broadcast after the digital television transition on a different channel. See File No. BPRM-20080620AON ("WFXG Petition"). The facility proposed by the WRLK Application would cause 3.68% unique interference to the facility proposed by the WFXG Petition. In addition, the facility proposed by the WFXG Petition would cause 0.69% unique interference to the facility proposed by the WRLK Petition.

4. The parties hereby agree to accept the interference described in Paragraph 3.


