On behalf of Sprint Nextel Corporation, Lawrence Krevor, Richard Engelman and Trey Hanbury met Friday with Bruce Gottlieb of the Office of Commissioner Michael Copps and Renée Crittendon of the Office of Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein. Consistent with its written submissions, Sprint Nextel recommended that the Commission use competitive bidding to assign the 700 MHz D Block spectrum. The Commission should also use targeted bidding credits to allow winning bidders to partially offset the costs associated with building a robust, nationwide interoperable public-private network that would directly benefit the public safety community.
