On August 27, 2008, Anna Gomez, Charles McKee, Pete Sywenki and I, all of Sprint Nextel, and our outside counsel, Richard Metzger of Lawler, Metzger, Milkman and Keeney, met with the following members of the Wireline Competition Bureau: Don Stockdale, Alex Minard, Bill Sharkey, Doug Slotten, Ted Burmeister, Katie King, Tom Buckley, Greg Guice, Marcus Maher, Al Lewis, Matt Warner, Nicholas Degani, Jeremy Marcus, Randy Clarke, and Victoria Goldberg. At this meeting, we discussed comprehensive reform of the intercarrier compensation system; the legal basis for adopting a bill-and-keep regime; justification of the \$.0007 cap for ISP-bound traffic; whether to implement access replacement mechanisms; reform of the USF contribution methodology; and Sprint Nextel's high-cost USF reform proposal (the High Cost Support plan filed on May 12, 2008 in CC Docket No. 96-45 and WC Docket No. 05-337). Sprint Nextel's comments were consistent with its previous filings in the above-captioned proceedings.
