**Re: Notification of *Ex Parte* Communication

Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Public Safety Spectrum Trust Corporation ("PSST") and Cyren Call Communications Corporation ("Cyren Call") hereby provide notice of a permitted *ex parte* communication.

On August 28, 2008, the undersigned, along with Michele Farquhar from Hogan & Hartson LLP, counsel to PSST, Morgan O'Brien from Cyren Call, and Elizabeth Sachs from Lukas, Nace, Gutierrez & Sachs, Chartered, counsel to Cyren Call, participated in a telephone conference with Erika Olsen, Deputy Chief of the Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau.

During the call, PSST and Cyren Call discussed the future re-auction of the D Block. In particular, PSST stated that while it retains a strong preference for a single, nationwide D Block licensee, it has begun exploring the merits of a state or regional licensing approach for the D Block based on recent discussions with potential bidders. PSST also discussed the public safety community's continuing need for a nationwide, interoperable broadband network and noted that if a state or regional licensing approach is used, the Commission should identify a single technology to be used throughout the network and adopt a legally binding governance structure to facilitate interactions among multiple D Block licensees and PSST, and to ensure interoperability and nationwide roaming.
