On behalf of Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”), Robin Cohen and Robert McNamara met Thursday, August 28, 2008, with John Schauble, Lynn Ratnavale, and Elizabeth Fishel of the Broadband Division of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. As described in the Public Interest Statement submitted with its applications¹, Sprint Nextel discussed the intermediate *pro forma* assignments involving Sprint Nextel’s licenses and leases that must take place in order to transfer only limited liability companies to New Clearwire. Sprint Nextel summarized possible procedures to effectuate these intermediate *pro forma* assignments and reiterated its request for prior approval of these wholly internal *pro forma* actions.
