Today, Samir Jain of WilmerHale, counsel to Verizon Wireless, and the undersigned met with Matthew Berry, FCC General Counsel, as well as Ajit Pai, David Horowitz, and Chris Killion of the Office of General Counsel to discuss the above-captioned proceedings. Our discussion focused on the information expressed in my testimony at the FCC's en banc hearing in Brooklyn, New York on July 31, 2008. In particular, we responded to a question from Chairman Martin as to whether or not the Commission currently has the legal authority to reallocate the D Block spectrum to public safety. We also noted that we believe a regional RFP approach would be more effective in addressing public safety's communications needs.
