Sprint is exiting the resale competitive local exchange services market in California in or after October 2008. The California Public Utilities Commission has named Verizon the default carrier for Sprint's remaining California local exchange customers.

1. Names of Parties to Transaction: Verizon California Inc. (acquiring company) and Sprint Communications Company L.P. (transferring company).
2. Types of Telecommunications Service Provided to Affected Customers: Sprint provides local telephone service to residential and small business customers in California. Verizon California Inc. will provide local telephone service to the transferred customers.
3. Date of Transfer: The transfer will occur on or after October 10, 2008.
4. Copy of the Notice Sent to Affected Customers: A copy of the customer notification letter is attached. The customer notification letter was sent to the affected customers on September 5, 2008.

We regret to inform you that as of October 10, 2008 Sprint will no longer be providing your local telephone service in California.
