

Pursuant to Section 10.210 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 10.210, Royal Street attests that it:

- (1) agrees to transmit Commercial Mobile Alert System ("CMAS") Alert Messages (as defined in the Commission's rules) in a manner consistent with the technical standards, protocols, procedures, and other technical requirements related to CMAS implemented by the Commission; and
- (2) commits to support the development and deployment of technology for the "C" interface, the CMS provider Gateway, the CMS provider infrastructure, and mobile devices with CMAS functionality and support of the CMS provider selected technology, as each of the foregoing terms is defined in the Commission's rules.
