Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 9, 2008, the undersigned (“Ms. Desai”) of Media Access Project met with Rudy Brioché, Legal Advisor, Media Issues to Commissioner Adelstein, and Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor, Media Issues to Commissioner Capps at the offices of the Federal Communications Commission. Pete Tridish (“Mr. Tridish”) of Prometheus Radio Project joined the meeting via conference call. At this meeting the parties generally discussed the positions of Prometheus as filed in its Comments and Reply Comments.

Additionally, Ms. Desai and Mr. Tridish stated that Auction 83 translators should not be eligible for use by AM stations until after the Commission has resolved the issue of priority between translators and low power radio stations, as per the many open issues before the Commission in the LPFM proceeding (MM Docket No. 99-25).

Ms. Desai and Mr. Tridish also stated that AM station use of FM translators should be allowed in only limited circumstances. Thus, only single station, daytime only stations should be eligible for FM translator use. Further, each station should only be allowed use of one FM translator.

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b), 47 C.F.R. §1.1206(b) of the Commission’s rules, this letter is being filed electronically with your office today.
