
Basic Interconnection Architecture & Compensation Framework

General Interconnection Transport Rule


Each sending carrier has the duty to deliver its traffic to the terminating carrier's Edge

Rural ILEC Interconnection Transport Rule


Non-Rural carrier chooses direct interconnection arrangement





Non-rural carrier means all carriers other than rural ILECs

Rural ILEC Interconnection Transport Rule (cont'd)


Non-Rural carrier chooses indirect interconnection arrangement




General 251(b)(5) Transport & Termination Framework




General 251(b)(5) Transport & Termination Framework (cont'd)
