On September 11, 2008, representatives of Time Warner Inc. and Time Warner Cable Inc. ("Time Warner Cable") held a series of meetings with Commission personnel to discuss the above-referenced transaction. Specifically, Susan Mort, Senior Counsel, Time Warner Inc.; Michael Hammer, Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, counsel for Time Warner Inc.; Steven Teplitz, Senior Vice President, Government Relations, Time Warner Cable; Cristina Pauze, Vice President, Federal Regulatory Affairs, Time Warner Cable; and Arthur H. Harding, Fleischman and Harding LLP, counsel for Time Warner Cable, participated in a five separate meetings with Commission staff as indicated below:


1. Michelle Carey, Senior Legal Advisor, Media Issues for Chairman Martin

During these meetings, the parties provided an overview of the structure of the pending transaction that will result in the immediate and complete separation of Time Warner Cable from Time Warner Inc., and explained the public interest benefits that will flow from the transaction. The parties summarized their responses on the record in these proceedings to program access and program carriage issues raised in the comments, demonstrating that there is no legal, factual or policy basis for the rules after the vertical integration between Time Warner Cable and Time Warner Inc. has been eliminated. Finally, the parties urged prompt and unconditional grant of the pending applications.
