Notice of Oral *Ex Parte* Communication


RE: Sprint Nextel Corporation and Clearwire Corporation Seek FCC Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations, **WT Docket No. 08-94**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 12, 2008, Gerry Salemm and Terri Natoli of Clearwire Corporation (“Clearwire”), a licensee, lessee, and operator of 2.5 GHz spectrum in the Broadband Radio Service (BRS) and Educational Broadband Service (EBS), met with Bruce Gottlieb and Scott Deutchman of the Office of Commissioner Michael Copps. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the recent applications filed by Clearwire for the approval of the transfer of control of licenses, authorizations, and *de facto* transfer spectrum leases held by Clearwire to a new wireless broadband company called Clearwire Corporation (“New Clearwire”). Clearwire reiterated certain of the points made in its application filed on June 6, 2008.¹
