Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to report that yesterday, September 15, 2008, I met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and Wayne Leighton, her Special Advisor for Wireless & International Matters. During the course of the meeting, we discussed the above-referenced proceedings, which concern the reauction of the 700 MHz D block.

In the discussion, I reiterated Qualcomm's position that the Commission should adopt technology neutral rules and not specify an air interface for any group of licenses. I also reiterated the fact that the 3G technologies, EV-DO and WCDMA/HSPA, are both very well suited to provide public safety with high speed, high capacity wireless broadband services. The 3G technologies are proven and are available today, and a deployment based on the 3G technologies would leverage the well developed 3G ecosystem and the economies of scale that stem from the fact that the 3G technologies are used today by well over 600 million people around the world for wireless broadband.
