Advantage Communications & Paging, FRN \_0016379380\_, hereby submits its initial election letter attesting that it intends to participate in the Commercial Mobile Alert System and transmit CMAS Alert messages to its subscribers.

Advantage Communications & Paging attests that it will provide CMAS alert messages for the following licensed facilities: WPEY798, WPKK579, AND WPKK585 in the following geographic regions only: Approximately a 100 mile radius of Wichita, Kansas and a 40 mile radius of Kansas City, Kansas.

Advantage Communications & Paging further attests that it: (1) agrees to transmit such alerts in a manner consistent with the technical standards, protocols, procedures and other technical requirements implemented by the Federal Communications Commission, and that it (2) commits to support the development and deployment of technology for the "C" interface, the Commercial Mobile Service ("CMS")/CMRS provider Gateway, the CMS provider infrastructure and mobile devices with CMAS functionality and support of the CMS provider selected technology.
