Today, Intel Capital President Arvind Sodhani met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate regarding the above captioned proceeding. Peter Pitsch and Marjorie Dickman of Intel Corporation, as well as Wayne Leighton of the Commissioner's office, were also present at the meeting.

During the meeting, Mr. Sodhani stated that FCC approval of the New Clearwire transaction will advance the public interest by expediting deployment of a nationwide mobile WiMAX network and increasing competition in the broadband marketplace. He explained that expeditious approval is a condition precedent to critical infrastructure funding and OEM platform decisions. In closing, Mr. Sodhani asserted that New Clearwire will indisputably enhance competition and urged expeditious approval of the transaction.
