On Monday, September 29, 2008, Brian Ford of the Organization for the Promotion and Advancement of Small Telecommunications Companies (OPASTCO), Carri Bennet of Bennet and Bennet, PLLC on behalf of the Rural Telecommunications Group (RTG), and Jill Canfield of the National Telecommunications Cooperative Association (NTCA) (collectively, the “Associations”) met with Renee Crittendon Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein’s office to discuss the proposed merger of Verizon Wireless and ALLTEL Wireless. The Associations expressed their view that the merger has the potential to seriously harm rural consumers, and thus the Commission should thoroughly examine the many questions this transaction raises, including holding a hearing pursuant to Section 309(e).¹
