On October 2, 2008, Craig Mundie, Chief Research and Strategy Officer for Microsoft Corp., met with Chairman Martin and Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, and Mr. Mundie and Paula Boyd of Microsoft, along with Edmond Thomas on behalf of Microsoft, met with Commissioner Copps and his Legal Advisor Rick Chesson, Commissioner Adelstein and his Legal Advisor Rudy Brioché, Commissioner Tate and her Legal Advisor Wayne Leighton, and Angela Giancarlo, Legal Advisor to Commissioner McDowell, regarding the television white spaces proceeding.

During these meetings, Microsoft discussed its support for white spaces operating parameters set forth in its previous filings, and in the filings of the White Spaces Coalition. Specifically, Microsoft discussed transmit power levels including power levels for adjacent channel operations, the appropriate detection threshold for spectrum sensing, the use of geolocation technologies, and the importance of an unlicensed framework.
