This letter is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, that on October 6, 2008, Marvin Ammori of Free Press spoke with Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Copps.

We discussed the status of the proceedings listed above regarding the expansion of full-power status and must-carry rights to some low power television stations. In particular, we expressed concern for extending must-carry rights to low-power and Class A stations primarily consisting of "home shopping" and to sponsored programming. We also discussed the potential benefits of expanding must-carry rights, including increasing the diversity of media ownership.
