On behalf of AT&T Services, Inc. Cathy Carpino, Mary Henze, Joel Lubin, Saikat Sen and the undersigned met with Aaron Goldberger and Don Stockdale, Al Lewis, Randy Clarke, Lynn Engledow, Bill Sharkey, Matt Warner, Chris Barnekov, Claude Aiken, Nicholas Degani and Jay Atkinson of the Wireline Competition Bureau on October 6, 2008. At the meeting, AT&T reviewed the results of a model run using pricing assumptions that apply a unified \$.0007 terminating rate by various carrier tracks. For the benchmarks evaluated, the SLC increase would be less than \$2 for 75% to 80% of primary lines. The attached presentation served as a basis for the discussion.
