This is to inform you that on Thursday, October 9, 2008, Pantelis Michalopoulos with Steptoe & Johnson LLP, Timothy Powers, Principle of Artemis Strategies, and the undersigned, all representatives of Leap Wireless International, Inc. ("Leap"), met with Erica Olsen, Acting Legal Advisor on Wireless Issues for Chairman Martin. Pantelis Michalopoulos and the undersigned also had a telephonic conversation with Renée Crittendon, Commissioner Adelstein's Legal Advisor for Spectrum and International Issues. In these meetings, participants discussed the status of the above-referenced proceeding and of the petitions for reconsideration filed by Leap and other parties in that proceeding. Leap representatives reiterated the need for the Commission to revisit and remove its "in-market" exception to the automatic roaming obligation, and urged the Commission to adopt efficient, market-based procedures for handling roaming complaints.
