On October 14, 2008 Bob Quinn and the undersigned on behalf of AT&T Services, Inc., met with Dana Shaffer and Don Stockdale of the Wireline Competition Bureau. In that meeting we discussed the respective obligations of interconnecting carriers in the context of comprehensive intercarrier compensation reform pursuant to section 251(b)(5) of the Act. We also discussed reform of the universal service contribution mechanism. Both discussions were consistent with AT&T's prior submissions on these matters.
