

Dear sir:

I am an electrical engineer, and an over-the-air television viewer from southern Lancaster PA. I watch the local stations, but also watch "long distance" out-of-market Baltimore and Philadelphia stations, because they provide better programming & more variety. In total I get approximately 15 stations.

Based upon what I've read, these white space devices would broadcast on top of these out-of-market Baltimore/Philly stations, and make them Not receivable. As a result I would only be able to watch four local channels. Going from 15 to 4 channels is not acceptable (in my humble opinion).

I ask that you restrain white-space devices from operating on channels 2 to 51, so that I can enjoy viewing OTA television without interference.
