

Good Day! I am writing to express my concern over the upcoming decision regarding the "white space" issue. As the Manager of a medium sized Audio Visual Department within a large resort, I am very concerned about the effect that the loss of available channels will have on our ability to operate wireless devices for production events. On any given day we rent out and operate nearly 10 to 30 wireless microphones within the UHF band. With the proposed changes, we will be severely limited in our ability to meet our clients needs. This will greatly hurt our business as well as the business of many major microphone, personal monitors devices and other such devices manufacturers. It is enough that our entire stock of equipment that operates within the 700MHZ range is now going to become obsolete as of Feb. 17th '09. Please re-consider any further damage that you are going to cause with this upcoming decision. Many small business, rental firms, production companies and theatres rely heavily on wireless devices that operate within the frequencies that you are thinking of handing over to other devices.
