On October 22, 2008, Mark A. Stachiw of MetroPCS Communications, Inc. ("MetroPCS"), along with Carl W. Northrop and Michael Lazarus of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP ("Paul Hastings"), met in person with Julius Knapp, Ira Keltz and Ahmed Lahjouji of the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology. The oral presentation in this meeting was consistent with the pleadings and *ex partes* filed on behalf of MetroPCS in the above-referenced proceedings, and specifically focused on the *ex parte* filed by MetroPCS in the above-referenced proceedings on October 20, 2008. In addition, MetroPCS discussed its view, using the coverage of its systems in Detroit and Dallas as examples, that a significant portion of its covered population in particular market areas would experience harmful interference under the Commission's proposed rules.
